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### **General information about this evaluation notebook**

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- This notebook is intended **only** for the students of the **Faculty of Medicine, Medicine in English Specialization, Titu Maiorescu University of Bucharest**.
  - The notebook consists of two sections: Medical Specialities and Surgical Specialities, with a total of **120 h of duty shift in the hospital (80 h for Medical Specialities and 40 h for Surgical Specialities)**.
  - Entries can be completed in whatever order, not necessarily in a chronological one, however all entries must be completed, evaluated and signed (both by the student and the evaluating physician)
  - All entries must be hand written
  - Not all duty hours must be performed in the same hospital, therefore each entry contains the name of the hospital and of the ward/department.
